south and central regions for security purpose while international organizations scare to work in this zone and that has been resulted children were vulnerable to recruit soldiers by the warring parts in the country, meanwhile Agency for Assistance and Development of Somalia-AADS is local NGO that works insecurity area last of 2 years for community development through collaboration with reliable donors such as: UNHCR, NRC, OXFAM NOVIB, AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL, UNICEF, UNPOS, SOMALI DIASPORA and T4H for different purpose of community support projects. In this regard, Agency for Assistance and Development of Somalia-AADS work with UNICEF for emergency education program, after Agency for Assistance and Development of Somalia-AADS and UNICEF have been both seen the education program is necessary to support this respective community in Bay region particularly in Baidoa IDPs, for instant Agency for Assistance and Development of Somalia-AADS has been received granted fund from UNICEF that bases six (6) year emergency education project.

### **Strategy**

Agency for Assistance and Development of Somalia-AADS has been managed to build 5 learning centers and functioning and have access of learning 2500 students from IDP and host community through collaboration of relevant authority and community elders in Baidoa district.

### **Project objective**

To provide accessible emergency education program, the most children for their families had been displaced their former houses for endless atrocity war in south Somalia and settled in Bay region partially in Baidoa district.

### **Achievement reached in one year emergencies education program**

- Constructed five (5) traditional class rooms in Baidoa IDP camps
- Installations three (3) Pakistani tents in Baidoa IDP camps
- 20 teachers have been recruited and provided way of teaching based on emergency
- All necessary emergency education subjects has been given
- Established fifty six (56) community education committee (CECs) and trained
- 2500 students have been enrolled during the period that in aggregated great one and great two consideration
- Grade two students are 97 out of 2400 total for aggregates students that are two classes.
